»» FOOD RELIEF @ MANIPUR

This report provides an update on the relief operations implemented within a camp in Manipur. The camp offers shelter and assistance to 90 families who are the displaced victims of the tribal conflict.



In response to the victims' requests, a variety of essential grocery items, including milk powder, toiletries, vegetables, canned food, eggs, and cooking oil were procured and distributed.

“I married a man from the other tribe. I have taken refuge here and my family is at home but we are unable to contact because of the prevailing connectivity issues.”
