Prema and her husband Krishnappa stay close to their small patch of land on which they cultivate for their living. This area borders the jungle and they live in constant fear of the wild animals which often ransack their crops and intrude into their living spaces. A closer look at the house reveals that it is a temporary structure with mud walls covered by plastic sheets. The recent rain caused additional damage and the floor is still damp. They are grateful for the tin sheets which would provide stability and security. Two families have been helped through this initiative in Chikkamagaluru in Karnataka.
