BAG DISTRIBUTION



With the help of friends from G-Network, we could organise this bag distribution to 90 students in Trinity English School, Assam.



Of the 90 children enrolled in the school, many come from families who struggle to afford a new school bag each year. Some children were carrying torn and worn-out bags, while others brought their books in whatever bags were available at home, often unsuitable in size and condition.

For many parents, purchasing a school bag or books meant making difficult choices at home. Some shared that they had to forgo a meal or give up buying a non-vegetarian item for the family in order to meet their children's school needs. These sacrifices highlighted how even a simple school bag can be a significant expense for a family living with limited resources.

We were privileged to reach out to this remote school in Purbazari, Assam, with timely support. By providing school bags to the children, we hope to ease a small part of the burden on their families.

FLOOD RELIEF



On 19 July, floods swept through several districts of Assam, leaving behind widespread damage and uncertainty. On 5 August, friends of the Cephas Foundation travelled to Sivasagar district and reached four affected villages.



Even weeks after the floods, waterlogging remained in several areas, while homes were filled with mud and debris. Many families had lost their belongings and were struggling to return to anything resembling normal life.



A truck was loaded with essential household items and was taken to the affected communities. Buckets, mugs, cooking vessels, toiletries, drinking water, and stationery for school-going children were distributed to families who had lost many of their basic possessions. More than 60 families received support through this relief effort.
